A UNIQUE TEAM-BUILDING OPPORTUNITY FOR UPPER PRIMARY CHILDREN



This 2-hour **ENTERPRISE** workshop begins with an engaging and collaborative whole-class learning experience around a giant board that celebrates some of our favourite traditional games, motivating children to create their own games with a set theme.

Then, working in small groups, participants will discover what they need to consider when designing games for a specific audience, and explore how they can communicate their message most effectively within strict budget guidelines, with the option of manufacturing and selling their new games.



Promoting fairness and inclusion, 'Let's Make a Game!' supports the four capacities at the heart of the Curriculum for Excellence, addressing specific outcomes in the subject areas of Art & Design, Health & Wellbeing, Literacy & English, Social Studies, and Technologies. Additional areas can be addressed through theme choice.

- respect others and make informed decisions
- examine the importance of clear rules
- develop an enterprising attitude, and lots more.
